For anyone who did not see the results on Class Dojo the final standings after KS1 and KS2 results were added together - were:

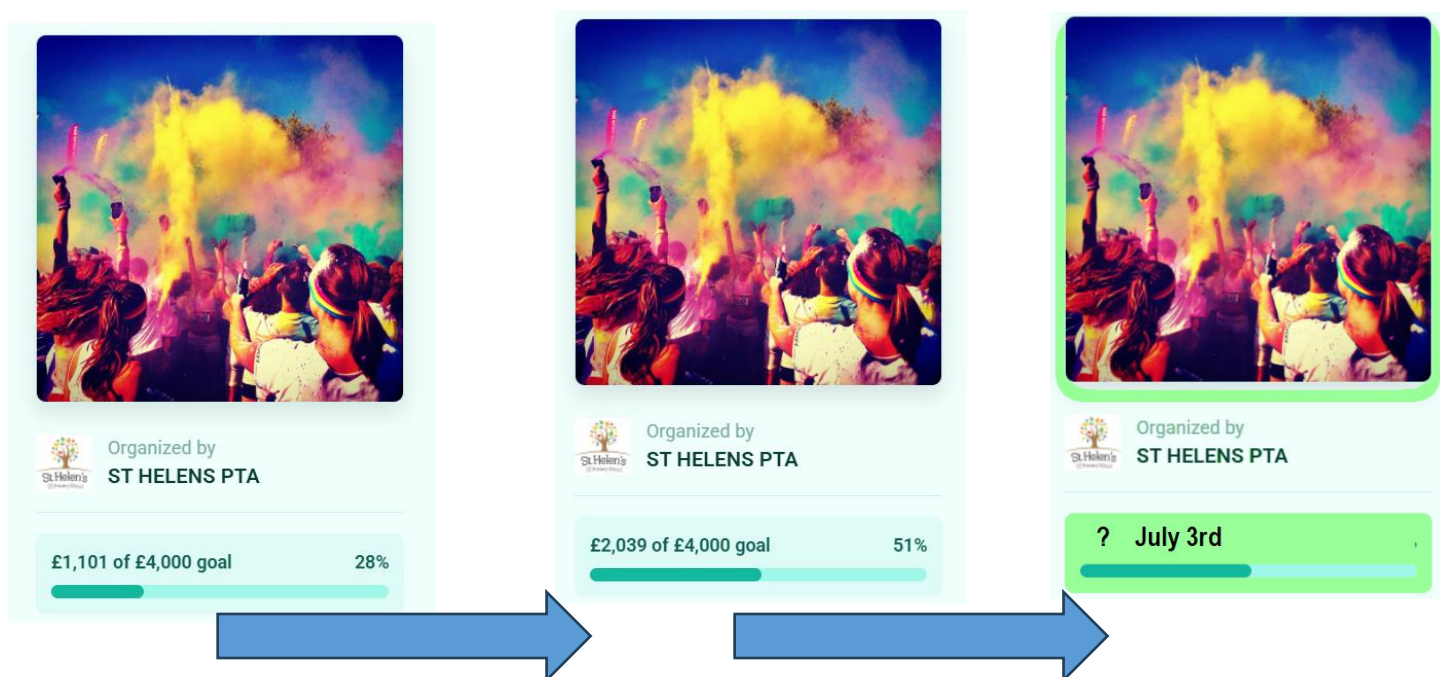
