### Some Facts (Knowledge & Understanding)

Florence Nightingale - also known as the 'Lady with the Lamp' - was the founder of modern nursing.

She was born to a wealthy family on the 12th May 1820 and was named Florence after the place of her birth: Florence in Italy.

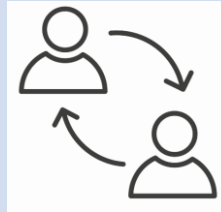
Florence Nightingale saved the lives of many soldiers during the Crimean War (1854-56).

She was dedicated to her profession and she worked hard day and night. She became known as the Lady with the Lamp as she carried a lamp to check on her patients throughout the night.

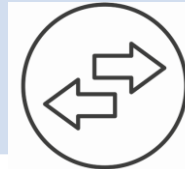


### Skills

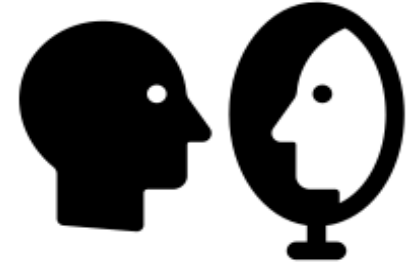

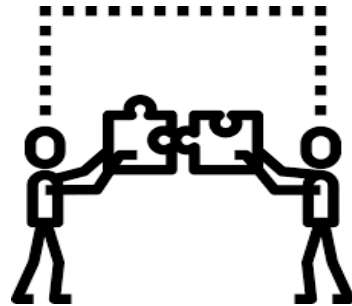

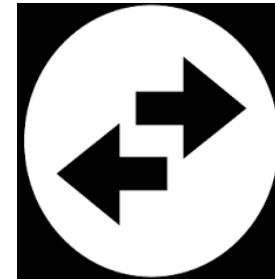
