




<ul style="list-style-type: none">For more than 1,500 years, the network of routes known as the Silk Road contributed to the exchange of goods and ideas among diverse culturesThe Silk Road extended approximately 6,437 kilometres (4,000 miles) across some of the world’s most formidable landscapes.The importance of the Silk Road on history. Religion and ideas spread along the Silk Road just as fluidly as goods. Towns along the route grew into multicultural cities. The exchange of information gave rise to new technologies and innovations that would change the world.Diseases also travelled along the Silk Road.
